

Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission — June 26, 2026

At 8:35 a.m., Chairman Taylor called the special meeting of the Stutsman County Commission to order. Mike Hansen (via telephone), Chad Wolsky, and Levi Taylor (via telephone) answered roll call. Ben Tompkins and Amanda Hastings were absent.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

No public comments were presented.

A motion to approve the agenda was made by Wolsky, seconded by Hansen. Unanimous aye vote. Motion carried.

Beau Ackerman, Land Agent, WBI Energy, (via telephone) presented alternate dates for the temporary closure of 94th Ave SE, near 35th St SE, for maintenance on an above-ground natural gas tap that has been submerged in water. The requested dates of the closure are August 31 – September 11, 2026. A motion to approve the request, contingent on the placement of detour signs being placed, and four loads of gravel being purchased by WBI to repair the alternate route, was made by Taylor, seconded by Wolsky. Roll call vote: Hansen, Wolsky, and Taylor voted aye. Motion carried.

Taylor presented a request for a temporary closure of 49th St SE (County Road 37) from 1st Street to 2nd Street, in the City of Montpelier, on July 4th from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., for the dedication of the Veteran's Memorial Wall. A motion to approve the request was made by Hansen, seconded by Wolsky. Roll call vote: Wolsky, Taylor, and Hansen voted aye. Motion carried.

At 8:45 a.m., a motion to adjourn the special meeting was made by Wolsky, seconded by Hansen. Unanimous aye vote. Motion carried.
