

Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission

October 16, 2007

At 8:00 a.m. the Stutsman County Commission mid-month meeting was called to order by Chairman Klose. Roll call was answered by Douglas Kaiser, Craig Neys, Dennis Ova, Dale Marks, and Mark T. Klose.

Mike Zimmerman, County Highway Superintendent, requested release of the budgeted funds for the employee awards banquet. Kaiser made a motion that was seconded by Ova to release \$1,500 for the awards banquet. Roll call vote - Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys and Klose voted aye.

Ova made a motion that was seconded by Kaiser to appoint Sandy Bendewald to the Stutsman County Housing Authority Board. Roll call vote - Marks, Kaiser, Neys, Klose and Ova voted aye.

A motion was made by Neys and seconded by Kaiser to nominate Sandy Bendewald to the South Central Human Service Center Advisory Council. Motion carried.

Steve Thompson, Interstate Engineering, presented the \$43,413.73 construction engineering contract for the County Highway 67 grade raise one mile south of Cleveland. Kaiser made a motion that was seconded by Marks to approve the contract contingent upon awarding bids for the project. Roll call vote - Kaiser, Neys, Klose, Ova and Marks voted aye.

Charles Davis informed the Commission of problems he had with the Ypsilanti Road construction contractor. He had a written agreement that required the contractor to dispose of the project's road debris in a silage pit. The contractor had only partially filled the pit. Marks made a motion that was seconded by Kaiser to not finalize the project and to withhold the retainage until the issue had been resolved. Motion carried.

Zimmerman reported that the wing walls on the Ypsilanti bridge had been repaired. The road contractor had proposed repairing the bridge at a cost of \$160,000. The method the contractor proposed would have closed the bridge for about a week during the early stages of the soybean harvest. A contractor from Colorado was hired and with the road department's assistance, the work was completed for about \$10,000.

Jim Fettig, Courthouse Maintenance Supervisor, requested approval of change orders for the Memorial Building restroom renovation project. Ova made a motion that was seconded by Marks to approve change orders for toilet partitions, new curb stop, mastic removal and blowing out the sewer lines at an estimated cost of \$8,100. Roll call vote - Neys, Klose, Ova, Marks and Kaiser voted aye.

Sandy Bendewald, Social Services Administrator, and Jim Fettig presented a plan that would renovate part of the main floor of the Memorial Building. The renovation would relocate the secure file room and fits into the long range plan of the building. It also provides additional room that is needed for personnel. Kaiser made a motion that was seconded by Marks to approve the project at a cost not to exceed \$33,000. Roll call vote - Klose, Ova, Marks, Kaiser and Neys voted aye.

Ova made a motion that was seconded by Kaiser to appoint Commissioner Neys as the County's delegate to the State Fair Board. Motion carried.

Ney's made a motion that was seconded by Ova to close County offices all day Monday, December 24, 2007. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Ova and seconded by Neys to approve \$52.50 in taxable meals. Motion carried.

Ova made a motion that was seconded by Neys to approve the mid-month bills. Roll call vote - Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys and Klose voted aye.
