

Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission

October 21, 2008

At 8:00 a.m., Chairman Klose called the mid-month meeting of the Stutsman County Commission to order. Dennis Ova, Dale Marks, Doug Kaiser, Craig Neys and Mark T. Klose answered roll call.

Agnes Jensen, County Librarian, was present at the request of Chairman Klose to answer questions regarding the ballot proposal to combine library services with the City of Jamestown. Jensen presented information regarding the Stutsman County Library and the bookmobile service. The revenues and expenditures of the County Library were discussed. The benefits of the bookmobile and having an adjacent garage for loading the bookmobile were also mentioned. She reviewed the schedule of the bookmobile along with the number of patrons served and time at each location. The bookmobile stops at various locations around the City of Jamestown with no compensation from the City for the service. Jensen estimated that approximately ten patrons a day from rural Stutsman County were served at the library.

Nina Schneider, Director Buffalo City Tourism Foundation, presented the tourism grant agreement between JSDC, Stutsman County and the Buffalo City Tourism Foundation. JSCD and Stutsman County would award the Foundation \$797,400 in funds over a four year period beginning January 1, 2009. The County's \$159,480 would be raised through the mill levy for economic development. The agreement was a renewal of a similar agreement that will expire. Ova made a motion that was seconded by Neys to approve the agreement. Roll call vote – Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys and Klose voted aye.

Jerry Bergquist, 9-1-1 Coordinator/Emergency Manager, requested approval of a resolution to appoint Mr. Bergquist as the applicant agent for the FY2009 Pre-Disaster Mitigation Grant Application. The 75/25, Federal/County grant for \$48,000 would provide funds for Nick of Time LLC to update the initial Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan that was first approved in 2003. The County's share of the cost would be paid "in kind". The update was necessary to continue to obtain assistance under certain disaster programs relating to mitigation and public assistance. Kaiser made a motion that was seconded by Marks to approve the resolution. Motion carried.

Mr. Bergquist also presented the contract for Aero-Metric to digitally photograph the City of Jamestown. Changes had been made to the contract based on recommendations of Interstate Engineering and the State's Attorney. Kaiser made a motion that was seconded by Ova to approve the amended contract. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Ova and seconded by Marks to appoint Tom Olson to the Garrison Diversion Conservancy District Board to fill the unexpired term of Maynard Helgaas. Roll call vote – Marks, Kaiser, Neys, Klose and Ova voted aye.

Marks made a motion that was seconded by Kaiser to appoint Craig Neys as the County's delegate to the North Dakota State Fair Association's annual meeting. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Ova and seconded by Neys to pay \$342.50 in taxable meals. Roll call vote – Kaiser, Neys, Klose, Ova and Marks voted aye.

Marks made a motion that was seconded by Neys to pay the mid-month bills. Roll call vote – Neys, Klose, Ova, Marks and Kaiser voted aye.
