

Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission — October 31, 2025

At 9:29 a.m., Chairman Taylor called the special meeting of the Stutsman County Commission to order. Ben Tompkins, Mike Hansen, Chad Wolsky, and Levi Taylor (via telephone) answered roll. Amanda Hastings was absent.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

No public comments were presented.

A motion to approve the agenda was made by Tompkins, seconded by Hansen. Unanimous aye vote. Motion carried.

Jesse Christianson, Highway Superintendent, requested award for the 2026 motor grader bids. Two total bids were submitted. The total bid for Butler Cat was \$1,015,900 for purchase of two machines. The net cost after trading of current equipment and buybacks of new equipment is \$374,400. The total bid for RDO was \$907,062 for purchase of two machines. The net cost after trading of current equipment and buybacks of new equipment is \$331,162. A motion to award the bid to RDO was made by Tompkins, seconded by Wolsky. Roll call vote: Tompkins, Hansen, Wolsky, and Taylor voted aye. Motion carried.

At 9:40 a.m., a motion to adjourn the special Commission meeting was made by Hansen, seconded by Wolsky. Unanimous aye vote. Motion carried.
