

Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission

November 17, 2009

At 8:00 a.m., Chairman Klose called the regular meeting of the Stutsman County Commission to order. Dennis Ova, Dale Marks, Craig Neys, Doug Kaiser and Mark T. Klose answered roll call.

Mike Zimmerman, County Highway Superintendent, requested permission to close the Road Department for the morning hours on November 18, 2009, to allow employees to attend the funeral of a road department employee. Marks made a motion seconded by Kaiser to allow the closing so employees could attend the funeral. Motion carried.

Ova made a motion seconded by Neys to pay \$142.50 in taxable meals. Roll call vote – Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys and Klose voted aye.

Noel Johnson, County COO, reported that some FEMA moneys were starting to come in.

Ova made a motion seconded by Neys to pay the mid-month bills. Roll call vote – Marks, Kaiser, Ney, Klose and Ova voted aye.

Commissioner Marks stated that a 1% sales tax would be proposed to the Jamestown City Council to raise funds for County and City infrastructure. Marks would visit with the State's Attorney to research the possibility of imposing a fuel tax.

Marks asked for a clarification of the approved road plan. The intent was to mill certain roads and when funding was available, the roads could be overlaid. Milling was required in any event. Klose stated that funding would be the determining factor in any project.

Johnson reported that the floor for the marina and the garage had been poured at Pelican Point Landing and the footings for the marina at Lakeside had been started. The house mover was ready to move the Lakeside marina building back in place as soon as the concrete had cured sufficiently.

Neys made a motion seconded by Ova to adjourn. At 8:21 a.m. the mid-month meeting of the Stutsman County Commission was adjourned.
