

Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission

November 20, 2007

At 8:00 a.m. the Stutsman County Commission mid-month meeting was called to order by Chairman Klose. Roll call was answered by Douglas Kaiser, Craig Neys, Dennis Ova, Dale Marks, and Mark T. Klose.

Eric Hoberg, Executive Director SCDRC, updated the Commission on the activities of the South Central Dakota Regional Council. The agency administrated four principal programs – Community Development Block Grants (CDBG), EDA (Economic Development Administration) revolving loan fund, small business development center and zoning work. The CDBG funds were used for public facility accessibility upgrades and for loans to assist private business. The EDA revolving loan fund provided another pool of funds for loans to small business. The small business development center had provided assistance to over 100 small business clients for assistance with start-ups, expansions, retentions and purchases. The Council was involved with acquiring existing small businesses from outside the area and relocating them within the region. Their food wise program’s goal was to work with commercial food preparation kitchens so they were not underutilized. The Council’s funding sources were from economic development grants, the Small Business Administration, grant administration funds, and dues from the participating counties within the region.
