

## Official Proceedings of the Stutsman County Commission

December 16, 2008

At 8:00 a.m., Chairman Klose called the mid-month meeting of the Stutsman County Commission to order. Dennis Ova, Dale Marks, Doug Kaiser, Craig Neys and Mark T. Klose answered roll call.

A motion was made by Ova and seconded by Kaiser to retroactively approve a gaming site authorization for Ducks Unlimited at 281 Stop for November 15, 2008. Motion carried.

Mike Zimmerman, County Highway Superintendent, presented the road policy manual. The road surcharge policy had been removed. The Commission reinstated the policy for future use, if necessary. A motion to approve the policy manual as amended was made by Neys and seconded by Marks. Roll call vote – Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys and Klose voted aye.

Zimmerman continued to work on road right of way encroachment issues and the right of way on old Highway 10. He requested permission to meet with the state, townships and cities along the road to try and resolve any jurisdiction issues. Kaiser made a motion that was seconded by Marks to proceed with the meeting. Motion carried.

Snow obstruction on county and township roads was creating a potential problem for blocking roads and creating safety concerns. Private property owners were pushing snow into piles on the roads and on the road right of ways. The Highway Superintendent and the Sheriff's Department would contact and/or send certified mail to the individuals causing the problem. If the problem continued, the Commission would consider a County ordinance to establish fines as penalties for violators.

Neys made a motion that was seconded by Marks to authorize Commissioner Kaiser to look at and purchase a 6 foot, 24" disc for Road Department shoulder and wind-row work for something less than \$2,500. Roll call vote – Marks, Kaiser, Neys, Klose and Ova voted aye.

Bids were opened for a front end loader and a backhoe for the Road Department. The bids for purchase of used equipment (1995 Case Extended Backhoe Loader/1986 Cat 980C Wheel Loader) were: Titan Machinery, Bismarck - \$22,000/\$33,600; Butler Machinery Company, Fargo - \$17,000/\$35,000; RDO Equipment, Bismarck - \$18,200/\$39,375; Vernon Lykken Company, Bismarck – Wheel Loader Only \$36,100.

Bids for sale of a new 180hp + front end loader were: Titan Machinery, Bismarck – (2009 Case 821E) \$172,805; Butler Machinery Company, Fargo – (2009 Cat 950H) \$205,667; RDO Equipment, Bismarck – (2009 JD 644K) \$209,500.

Bids for sale of a new 95hp backhoe loader were: Titan Machinery, Bismarck – (2009 Case 580SM) \$81,500; Butler Machinery Company, Fargo – (2009 Cat 430E) \$95,316; RDO Equipment, Bismarck – (2009 JD 410J) \$96,500.

Sheriff Dave Orr requested permission to trade in a vehicle for a 2008 program car for approximately \$9,100. He had about \$15,000 in his 2008 budget that would not be spent. Marks made a motion that was seconded by Ova to allow the purchase. Roll call vote – Kaiser, Neys, Klose, Ova and Marks voted aye.

Eunice Sahr, County Extension Agent representing the County Wellness Committee, requested extending the County Wellness program for another year. Employees may get up to 8 hours wellness time off for charting their healthy lifestyle choices. The County received a 1% reduction in health insurance premiums for having a wellness program. Neys made a motion that was seconded by Ova to extend the program for another year. Motion carried.

Noel Johnson, County COO, requested selecting the contractor for GIS services for the acquisition of a road centerline GIS file for the City of Jamestown. Four firms had submitted proposals. A committee of City and County personnel recommended Bullberry Systems, Inc. for the project. This company was considered the best and most cost effective bid, and they currently provide GIS services for the County's Emergency Management software. A motion was made by Kaiser and seconded by Ova to select Bullberry Systems, Inc for the project. Roll call vote – Neys, Klose, Ova, Marks and Kaiser voted aye.

Tracey Trapp, LEC Administrator, requested acceptance of a \$10,000 homeland security grant to acquire video conferencing equipment for the meeting rooms in the lower level of the Law Enforcement Center. 34 agencies were involved with the process of allocating the \$37,138 in 2008 grant awards. A motion was made by Marks and seconded by Kaiser to accept the grant award. Roll call vote – Klose, Ova, Marks, Kaiser and Neys voted aye.

Kaiser made a motion that was seconded by Ova to approve the beer license applications of Judith Ganser dba Anchor Bar, Inc., Wayne and Hilda Kuntz dba Sportsman’s Bar, and Joey Uehran dba 281 Stop. Motion carried.

Johnson reviewed the 2008 General Election costs. The total cost was \$28,330 or \$2.33 per vote. The cost was \$5.48 per vote for the 2008 Primary; \$3.40 per vote for the 2006 General; \$5.74 per vote for the 2006 Primary; \$2.23 for the 2004 General; and \$10.05 per vote for the 2004 Primary.

A motion was made by Ova and seconded by Neys to pay \$627.50 in taxable meals. Roll call vote – Ova, Marks, Kaiser, Neys and Klose voted aye.

Marks made a motion that was seconded by Kaiser to pay the mid-month bills. Roll call vote – Marks, Kaiser, Neys, Klose and Ova voted aye.
