**WCO Report** – The WCO let the board know once again he would be attending numerous agriculture and recreational shows in the next few months, most Ag shows that the WCO plans on attending will be wrapped up by the end of Winter Show, in Valley City, in early March. Then he will start on hiring a working crew for the summer and getting everyone certified and trained. The WCO informed the board that he has spoken with a few retired people in the community that would be interested in working here on a “not so” full-time basis. He will also have a few NDSU certification training courses to talk at also.

The WCO informed the board that he has signed up himself and Cody Wegner for the Western Invasive Weed Short Course training in Loveland, Colorado, April 20-23rd. They will be attending the training with four other Weed Control officers from the state of North Dakota. The course focuses on integrated weed management for professionals.

**Old Business-** The WCO was able to print off a publication of optional vegetation management practices at Utility-Scale Solar Sites. Discussion with the board centered around the fact that the North Dakota Noxious Weed Law and Regulations under the ND century code will be our primary guide as a Weed Board when making decisions on any incoming projects such as this.
