The Financial Report and bills were presented to the Weed Board. Councilman Brian Kamlitz moved that the financials and bills, which were reviewed by the board, be approved. Randy Neva seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The WCO also let the board know that he and Cody finished a zoom recertification for commercial applicators the day before in the office. We still must find a spot to recertify for the ornamental and turf certification sometime this spring, or we will have to take the test again.

Old Business-

New Business- After the WCO handed out copies of the Stutsman County policies concerning Group Health Insurance and Retirement. Discussion was held amongst the Weed Board about adding an additional seasonal benefited position to our department. Councilman Brian Kamlitz moved that the Stutsman County Weed Board create another seasonal position in this department. This position would receive county benefits and would receive a pay grade 8 starting salary. Greg Spenningsby seconded the motion. Motion carried with a unanimous vote in favor by the board.

The Stutsman County Weed Board opened the solicited bids for its' chemical purchases for the 2026 season. After opening and discussion about the bids presented, Greg Spenningsby moved to accept and approve the chemical bid from Nutrien Ag. Ben Lee seconded the bid. Motion carried to accept and purchase chemicals for the 2026 season from Nutrien Ag.

With no other business to discuss, Councilman Ben Lee made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Richard seconded. Chairman Bob Martin adjourned the meeting at 7:58am.
